All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

about one fourth mile west from Few's Chapel Church, lying on the south side of the Few's Bridge Road, and being bounded on the north by the said Road and lands of A. L. Cannon, on the East by other lands of myself, on the south by lands I. F. Few, and on the West by lands of Harold Few, and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by deed from I. F. Reese Oct. 9th, 1918, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. in and for Greenville County in Deed Book 50 at page 160, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin in the southern edge of the Few's Bridge Road, being the joint corner of A. C. Cannon, Harold Few and the land being conveyed, and runs thence with Harold Few's line, S. 17-30 E. 810.5 feet to an I. P. in branch, I. F. Few's corner; thence with the I. F. Few line N. 38-30 E. 251 feet to an iron pin on said line; thence a new line N. 17-30 W. 668.5 feet to a point in center of Few's Bridge Road; thence with the said road S. 77-45 W. 208.6 feet to the beginning corner, and containing three and 67/100 (3.67) acres, more or less.
