and having the following metes and bounds:

"Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the Old Piedmont Road running thence N. 66 W. 7.13 to a stake; thence S. 68.50 W. 7.13 to an iron pin, thence N. 49 W. 3.90 to a stake, (thence N. 42 W. 3.11 to a stake,) thence N. 73.75 E. 4.22 to a stone, thence N. 32.75 W. 8.20 to a stone, thence N. 80.25 W. 15.25 to a stake, thence N. 84 W. 1.04 to a stone, thence S. 1 W. 4.37 to the beginning corner said tract of land is bounded on the East by Highway #29, and on the North by lands of P. M. Huff and on the South by lands of the Eskew estate and Edward King, and on the West by Mrs. Cason and the Eskew lands. Said tract of land contains Ten and one-tenth acres, more or less.
