All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

in a subdivision known as "Sunny Slope", and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 9 and 11, of Block A, as shown on plat of said subdivision recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 86, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Zarline Street at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 9, of Block A, which point is 201.9 feet south of the southeast corner of the intersection of Fortner St., and Zarline St., and running thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 7 and 9, of Block A, S. 80-12 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 9-48 W. 103 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 11 and 13, of Block A; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 80-12 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Zarline St.; thence along the line of said street, N. 9-48 E. 103 feet to the beginning corner.

Lot No. 9, of Block A, is the same lot conveyed to me by C. B. Martin by deed dated Nov. 18, 1943, not yet recorded; and Lot No. 11, of Block A, is the same lot conveyed to me by Lou Mae Elder by deed dated Feb. 17, 1939 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 209, page 45.
