All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northeast side of Bates Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 25 on plat of Skyland Park, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, March 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book L, at page 41, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit :

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Bates Avenue at joint front corner of lots Nos. 24 and 25, said pin also being 352.4 feet in a Northwesterly direction from the point where the Northeast side of Bates Avenue intersects with the Northwest side of Webster Road, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 24, N. 65-43 E. 188.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 47-0 W. 85 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 26, S. 55-35 W. 162.4 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Bates Avenue; thence with the Northeast side of Bates Avenue, S. 28-39 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
