Anderson Forrester and Ella Forrester Stokes

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Anderson Forrester and Ella Forrester Stokes, their heirs and assigns forever:-

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in..... Highland .....Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,  
containing twelve acres, more or less, and Being in Jordan High School District, on the north side of the road leading from the Rutherford Road to Few's Chapel Road, adjoining lands of W. T. Forrester, W. H. Martin and Melvin, and known as part of tract #2 of the Henry H. Forrester land, as shown on plat by W. P. Morrow, Surveyor, and BEGINNING at iron pin on Rutherford Road in the intersection of what is known as Five Forks, W. T. Forrester's corner, and runs thence with the W. T. Forrester line N. 83-00 W. 26.50 chains to stone, W. T. Forrester's corner; thence S. 9-60 W. 66 links to stake on bank of Beaver Dam Creek; thence with said Creek, S. 20-00 W. 2.60 chains to stake and turn; thence S. 3-00 E. 2.60 chains to turn; thence S. 4-00 E. 1.92 chs. to stake on east bank of said Beaver Dam Creek, W. H. Martin's corner; thence with his line to stake in center of above mentioned road; thence with said road, N. 35-45 E. 1.51 chains to turn; thence N. 56-16 E. 6.06 chains to a turn; thence N. 65-30 E. 1.51 chs. to turn; thence S. 85-45 E. 3.03 chs. to turn; thence N. 86 E. 2.33 chs. to the beginning corner, containing twelve and seven-tenths (12.7 acres, more or less, and being part of the lands conveyed to Mettie M. Melvin by W. H. Martin.
