Whereas, there is no community property for adjustment, now, therefore In consideration of the premises and in consideration of the covenants hereinafter more specifically set out, the said first party and said second party do, and each of them does renounce any and all marital rights which each owes to the other, of any kind or nature, whether legal, moral or equitable, and each renounces, quitclaims and conveys hereby all such rights to the other, and in consideration of \$300.00 paid by first party to second party, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by second party, said second party and first party agree to live separate and apart each from the other from this time on, meither party to bother or in any way molest the other party, or hinder them in any way in their respective going to and from any place whatsoever that may be desired by either party, said second party releases first party from any and all claim for support, alimony or other support of any nature whatsoever and said second party further does hereby, after being privately and separately examined by the undersigned Notary Public, declare that she does freely, voluntarily and without any compulsion, dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever, renounce, release and forever relinquish unto said first party, or to any person to whom he may seel, his or their heirs or assigns, all her interest and estate, and also all her right and claim of Dower, in or to all and singular any and all premises, or real estate now owned by said first party or which may be hereafter owned by him.
