All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the West side of Ledbetter Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Ledbetter Street, which point is 120 feet from the intersection of Easley Bridge Road and Ledbetter Street, and is the rear corner of property now or formerly of R. M. Dacus, and running thence with Dacus line approximately S. 69-45 W. 130 feet, more or less; thence N. 17-14 W. 88.4 feet, more or less; thence N. 68-37 E. 70 feet; thence S. 16-50 E. 38 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 68-37 E. 60 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Ledbetter Street; thence with Ledbetter Street, S. 16-50 E. 50.4 feet to the beginning corner.
