CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

WHEREAS, John E. Stathos, G. P. Giannakas

and

Peter G. Kyriakakas, all of Greenville, S. C.

two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affairs of Association of St. Trinity of Xerocampion,

which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 9th day of August, A. D. 1944, file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for a Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Charitable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, otherwise than is above stated, or for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days' notice in the Greenville News, a newspaper published in the County of Greenville has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, That said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST. Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND. The name of the proposed Corporation is ASSOCIATION OF ST. TRINITY OF XEROCAMPION.

THIRD. The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH. The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to assist in the rehabilitation of citizens of Xerocampion, Province of Sparta, Greece, who have suffered the revages of War; to similarly assist American citizen who themselves or their ancestors were citizens of Xerocampion, Province of Sparta, Greece, whether within or without the United States, who have suffered the revages of War; to conduct research and investigations in Europe and elsewhere to determine the fate of residents of Xerocampion, Providence of Sparta, Greece, in Europe to generally assist all needy persons, formerly residents of Xerocampion, Province of Sparta, Greece or who can trace direct ancestry to Xerocampion, Province of Sparta, Greece.

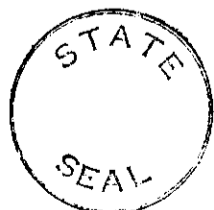

SIXTH. That they desire to be incorporated. In perpetuity

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W. P. Blackwell 1932, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter 158, Article III Code of 1932 and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter 158, Article III Code of 1932, and Acts amendatory thereto. Sections 8158-8159 and 8160, Code of 1932, and Acts amendatory thereto.
