Beginning at a stake 250 feet north of the Simpsonville-Anderson Bridge surface treated road, corner of lots #1 and 3 and running thence, N. 38-00 W. 2220 feet to a cluster of white oaks; thence, N. 64-45 E. 375 feet to a sweetgum; thence, N. 12-15 E. 541 feet to a stake; thence, N. 85-45 E. 406 feet to a stake; thence, N. 13-15 W. 327 feet to a stake; thence, N. 67-45 E. 270 feet to a stone; thence, S. 6-45 E. 495 feet to a stake at the creek near the mouth of a branch; running thence, up said branch as the line S. 9-30 E. 400 feet to a bend; thence, S. 9-30 W. 332 feet to a bend; thence, S. 28-45 E. 204 feet to a bend; thence, S. 40-30 E. 838 feet to bend; thence, S. 50 E. 210 feet to an iron pin; thence, S. 49 E. 175 to a poplar stump; thence, S. 20-30 E. 152 feet to a stake; thence, S. 56-30 W. 853 feet to the beginning corner and containing 50.60 acres, more or less, as shown on plat of survey made of lands of the late Mrs. Nannie H. White in March 1936 by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor.
