W. L. Hester, his Heirs and assigns.

All that piece, parcel and tract of land lying situate and being in Paris Mt. Township State and County aforesaid adjoining lands of C. B. Wynn tract No. 1 and 3. Known as a Part of the land conveyed to me by deed from Arthur L. Ewbank as Executor of the last will and testament of Henry Ewbank and in the division as tract No. 2.

Beginning on an iron pin on the White Horse Road thence with C. B. Wynns line S. 78 E. 21.00 to an iron pin thence N. 84 E. 8.50 to iron pin corner of tract No. 3, thence N. 17 W. 10.16 to an iron pin corner of tract No. 1, 3 and 4 thence S. 82 W. 12.60 to an iron pin, thence N. 69 W. 13.50 to an iron pin in the White Horse Road, thence down said Road S. 9 W. 7.60 to a bend thence S. 6 E. 1.82 to the beginning corner and contains 23 acres more or less.

Also all that other piece and lot of land lying situate and being in Paris Mt. Township State and County aforesaid on the East side of the Finley Bridge Road. Known as a part of the land conveyed to me by deed from Arthur L. Ewbanks deed recorded in R.M.C. Office Greenville County, S. C. on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of Jan. 1904 and in the Subdivision as tract No. 8, adjoining lands of myself, C. B. Wynn, and Tract No. 7. Beginning on a Pine x 3 o.m. C. B. Wynns corner, thence running N. 22 W. 4.00 to an iron pin, thence S. 63 W. 5.66 to a stake in the Findley Bridge Road thence with said Road S. 60 E. 2.87 to a stake in said Road thence N. 85 1/2 W. 4.54 to the beginning corner and contains 1.45 acres, more or less.
