All that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the city and county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, on the South side of Alaska Avenue, and known and designated as Lot #10 of Parkview, a plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C.'s Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "M" at page 49 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Alaska Avenue, which iron pin is 50 feet East of the Southeastern intersection of Alaska Avenue and Neely Drive (this point is taken from projecting the lines of the two streets since the intersection is a curve instead of a corner), joint corner of Lots #10 and 11, running thence along the joint line of said lots S. 36-17 E. 150 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of said lots; thence N. 53-43 E., 50 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of Lots #9 and 10, thence along the joint line of said lots N. 36-17 W., 150 feet to an iron pin in the line of Alaska Avenue; thence along the line of Alaska Avenue S. 53-43 W., 50 feet to the point of beginning.

The above property is sold subject to the restrictions recorded in the R.M.C.'s Office for Greenville County in Deeds, Volume 245 at page 138, on June 6, 1942.
