TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, C. Rivers Stone and T. C. Stone individually and as Executor of the Will of Floride Lydia Stone

on or about the 17th day of June in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-seven exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Charles B. Stone, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 4th day of August, 1947, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to R. L. Bridges and H. Eugene Trammell

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. E-11,159.)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said R. L. Bridges and H. Eugene Trammell

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville, South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the Buncombe Road near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, and according to a plat of C. B. Dawsey, dated June 1947, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of Buncombe Road and Morris Street and running thence along Morris Street S. 79-30 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 11 W. 111.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 11-80 W. 100 feet to an iron pin on Buncombe Road; thence along Buncombe Road N. 11 E. 114 feet to the point of beginning."
