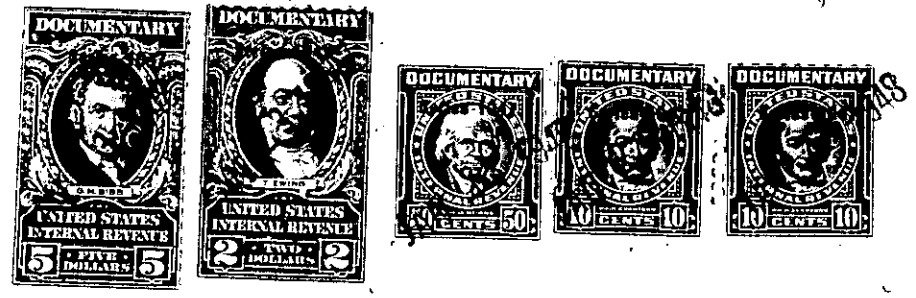
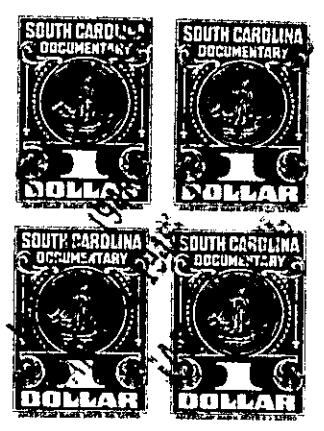

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. W. Bishop and Florine F. Bishop

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butlar Township, Greenville,  
County, State of South Carolina about seven miles southeast of City of Greenville,  
and containing 31 1/2 acres, more or less, Adjoining lands of W.H.Henderson,  
Paskel King, and lots nos. 2 and 4 in the division of Jno. Vaughn, deceased,  
and being same tract of land conveyed to W. P. Conyers by Martha E.  
Harrison, deed recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville Co. Vol.  
20 at page 426. And being the same tract of land conveyed to the Grantor  
herein by Gracie Eva Ward by her deed dated December 10th, 1938, and deed  
recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 207  
at page 243.
