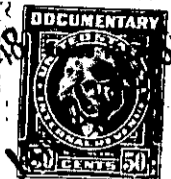

County, State of South Carolina, and designated as a part of Lot 2 on a plat made by J. Coke Smith & Son, Surveyors, December 1, 1947, said plat recorded in Plat Book R, at Page 165, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the White Horse Road joint corners of Lots 1 and 2, thence N. 68-45 W. 175 ft. to iron pin, thence S. 11-15 E. 124.5 ft. to iron pin, thence S. 68-45 E. 175 ft. to iron pin joint corners of Lots 2 and 3 on White Horse Road, thence along White Horse Road N. 11-45 E. 125 ft. to the point of beginning and being a portion of the property deeded to me by J.
