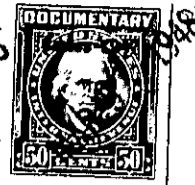

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said CLAUDE MELVIN SHAW, JR., his heirs and assigns forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on the south side of West Boulevard, near the intersection of West Boulevard and the White Horse Road, and being a lot bounded on the north by West Boulevard, and on all other sides by lands of the grantor herein. Said lot being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of West Boulevard, which pin is S.78-12 W. 155 feet from the southwest corner of West Boulevard and White Horse Road, and running thence with the south side of West Boulevard, S.78-12 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, thence S.11-48 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, thence N.78-12 E. 70 feet to an iron pin, thence N.11-48 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
