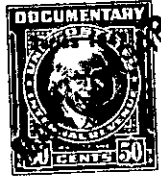

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *H. A. Henson Sr.*
and H. A. Henson Jr.

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in *Bates* Township, *Greenville*

County, State of South Carolina *H. D. Burn* on the South
Geer Highway on the East S. P. Bates on the
west Beginning on corner of the drug
store thence running through *H. D. Burn*
store N 68 W 65 feet to i. P. 15 feet from
the Drug store thence N 26 E 106 feet
to i. P. thence S 12 E 126 feet to the Beginning
corner and contains in the Courtyard
the Drug store and Barber Shop.
