presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. S. Paget, and his Heirs and
Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, near the northern limits of the Town of Greer,
on the south side of a proposed 30-foot street running east from
Pine Street Extension, and designated as Lot No. 9 on plat of the
property of Evelyn Gentry, prepared by H. B. Brockman, Surveyor,
April 12, 1941, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at the corner of Lot #3 on said Street, and runs thence
S. 2.45 W. 225 feet to point, corner of Lot #1 on line of Mountain
View Cemetery; thence with Cemetery line, S. 89.12 E. 82.8 feet to
corner of Lot No. 10; thence with line of Lot No. 10, N. 0.48 E. 224.9
feet to point on edge of said proposed street; thence thence with N.
89.12 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner, bounded on the north by
