County, State of South Carolina, lying east from the St. Mark Road, about one
mile north from Chick Springs and the new U. S. Super Highway No.
29 and being all of lots 22 through 28 as shown on Plat of W. B.
Williams Property made by H. L. Donahoo, Surveyor, dated January
21st 1947, and being a part of the same property that was conveyed
to me by deed from W. B. Williams February 10th 1947 and recorded
in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book
308 at page 402, and having the following courses and distances,
to wit:-

Beginning on a stake at the intersection of two roads or
streets, the northeastern corner of lot No. 28, and runs thence
with northern edge of road or street, S. 38-53 W. 400 feet to a
stake, joint corner of lots 27 and 29; thence with the common line
of these lots in a northerly direction 115 feet to a stake, the
southeastern corner of lot No. 26; thence S. 63-30 W. 332 feet to
a stake, joint corner of lots 21, 22, 30 and 34; thence with the line
of lots 21 and 22 in a northerly direction 150 feet to a stake on the
south edge of road or street; thence N. 64-00 E. 150 feet to a stake;
thence N. 65-10 E. 200 feet to a stake; thence N. 69-00 E. 100 feet
to a stake; thence N. 69-50 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner.
