to us paid by Greenville County

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville County

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina. ^{Beginning} One foot from the joint corner of James H. Campbell, Moffitt, and Welcome School a strip twenty feet wide through said Campbell land running N. 65-15 E. and one foot from the line of Moffitt cut from the south side of Lot 14 as shown by a plat of Mable McB. Charles recorded in Plat Book "F", page 95, to J. M. Fortner line which line is a line of tract No. 13 of Charles plat; thence a strip thirty-five feet wide having as its center the iron pipe in the center of Oak Drive which is the northeast corner of Lot 12 according to the said Charles plat. The intention of this deed is to vest in Greenville County said strips of land as a public road but to reserve one foot along said Campbell's line of said Lot 14 leaving the land owned by Moffitt cut off from said road by one foot width. This road will allow for an outlet or road from Oak Drive by Welcome School to White Horse Road. To be called Crescent Street.
