

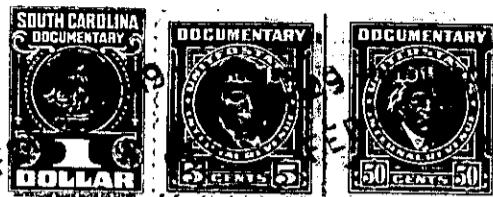

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named,
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
does grant, bargain, sell and release unto ULYSSES M. GREEN, His Heirs and Assigns,
Forever:

All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
situate, lying and being on the South side of Maryland Avenue,
near the Town of Greer, in Chick Springs Township, County of
Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and
designated as Lot No. 62 on plat of Development No. 2, Victor-
Monaghan Company, Division of J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc., Greer
Plant, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April, 1947, and
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat
Book P, at page 119, and having, according to said plat, the
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the South side of Maryland
Avenue, joint front corner of Lots No. 61 and 62, and running
thence along the common line of said lots, S. 35-21 W. 296.6 feet
to a point on the right-of-way of the main line of the Piedmont
and Northern Railway Company; thence S. 77-22 E. 119.2 feet to a
point at the joint rear corner of Lots No. 62 and 63; thence along
the common line of said lots, N. 35-21 E. 250.6 feet to a point
on the South side of Maryland Avenue; thence along the South side
of Maryland Avenue, N. 54-39 W. 110 feet to the beginning corner.

The property herein conveyed is subject to the re-
strictive covenants which are recorded in the R. M. C. Office
for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 310, at page 417, reference
to which is hereby made.

This being part of the same property conveyed to the
grantor herein by Victor-Monaghan Company by deed dated August
31, 1946, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
