All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Northern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue, within the limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot # 25, Pleasant Valley, as per plat thereof prepared by Dalton & Neves in April, 1946, as revised through November, 1948, as recorded in the R.M.C. Office, Greenville, South Carolina, in Plat Book "P", at Page 92, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue at joint front corner of Lots # 24 and # 25, said pin being 695 feet Southwest of iron pin on the Northern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue in the Northwest corner of the intersection of Pleasant Ridge Avenue with Long Hill Street; thence N. 0-08 W. 160 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots # 24 and # 25; thence S. 89-52 W. 60 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots # 25 and # 26; thence S. 0-08 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue at joint front corner of Lots # 25 and # 26; thence N. 89-52 E. 60 feet along said Avenue to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots # 24 and # 25, the point of beginning.
