Know all Men by these presents, That I, George H. Mull, of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

Eighty-Five Hundred and No/100 - - - - - (\$8500.00) - - -Dollars

to me paid by Virginia M. Lewis

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Virginia M. Lewis, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Ward Two of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 36, of Section H, of a subdivision of the property of the Stone Land Company, as shown on plat thereof re-recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at page 277 (except the Northern 2 feet of said lot previously sold), and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Bennett Street at a point 2 feet South of the corner of Lot No. 34, which point is 287 feet South of the intersection of Stone Avenue, and running thence along the West side of Bennett Street, S. 20-19 W. 53 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 38; thence along the line of Lot No. 38, N. 71-50 W. 217 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot; thence N. 20-19 E. 53 feet to an iron pin at a point 2 feet South of the rear corner of Lot No. 34; thence on a line parallel with said Lot No. 34, S. 71-50 E. 217 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is the same property conveyed to me by Nell Jones McAlister by deed dated June 2, 1942 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 245, page 102.

The grantee is to pay taxes for 1949, said taxes having been pro-rated as of this date.
