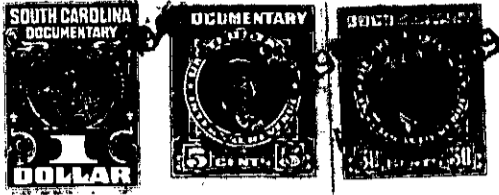

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That We, Furman B. Massingale, Jr., and Mary W. Massingale, of the County of Greenville,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Joe L. Coleman,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Joe L. Coleman, his heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being Lot Number Four (No. 4) on plat of property of F. B. Massingale made by J. Coke Smith, May 15th, 1947, and, according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the northern side of Arch Street Extension, at corner of Lot No. 5, and running thence in a northwesterly direction with line of Lot No. 5, One Hundred Sixty (160) feet to a stake; thence S. 60-40 W. 60 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 3; thence with line of Lot No. 3 in a southeasterly direction, One Hundred Sixty (160) feet to a stake on the edge of Arch Street Extension; and thence in an easterly direction with the northern side of Arch Street Extension, Sixty (60) feet to the beginning corner.
