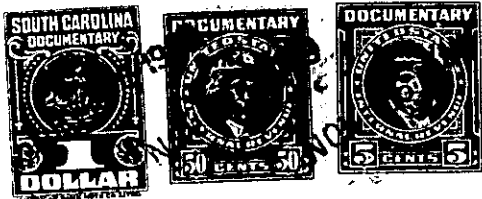

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Gary J. Davis

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
Two Hundred (200.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by J. P. Eldridge

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. P. Eldridge

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, about six miles north of Greer, S. C., and lying
on the west side of the Day's Bridge road, and described as follows:

BEGINS AT a point or pin in the center of said road five (5) feet
north of the southwest corner of 3.45 acre tract of W. E. Duncan, as
shown on a plat of the property of C. W. Anderson, Jr., H. S.
Freeman, Surveyor, June 5, 1948, and running in the easterly
direction 210 feet to a point or pin, thence in a westerly
direction 420 feet to a point or pin on the line between
Grantor and Mitchell land as shown on said plat, thence in a
line between Grantor and Mitchell S. 46-4, E. 210 feet to a point
or pin in center of said Day's Bridge road, joint corner between Grantor
and said W. E. Duncan tract of 3.45 acres; thence in a westerly
direction S. 2-35 E. 420 feet to the beginning corner, and being
two acres, more or less, and being a part of the land conveyed by
deed of I. M. Duncan and Fannie Lee Duncan dated November 24,
1946, and recorded in Deed Book 301, page 241.

State of South Carolina, Greenville, Release.
