

Greenville County, State of South Carolina, School District 9-H, on the northern side of Vandeventer Drive (or Street), and being a portion of lot #14 on plat of the property of grantor, prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, February 24, 1942, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-
