Provided, however, that no rental shall accrue or become due until such time as a suitable service station, according to lessee's plans and specifications, shall have been (a) constructed upon the demised premises by the lessor as hereinafter provided, and (b) completed, equipped and delivered to lessee for the transaction of lessee's business.

- (c) Lessor further agrees that in the event any structures on said premises are damaged or destroyed, lessor (c) Lessor further agrees that in the event any structures on said premises are damaged or destroyed, lessor shall notify lessee within twenty (20) days from the date of such destruction or damage whether or not lessor intends to restore the premises to their former condition and if lessor so elects to restore the premises to their former condition, lessor shall replace within one hundred twenty (120) days any such structures damaged or destroyed in any manner. If lessor fails to notify lessee within said twenty (20) day period or notifies lessee that lessor does not intend to restore the premises, or fails to restore the same, lessee at its election may immediately terminate the lesse effective as of the date the damage or destruction occurred, in which event rental shall abate from the date of destruction or damage, or do the necessary repairing or rebuilding itself and have the right to apply accruing rentals to reimburse itself for the principal expenditure, together with interest at six per cent. If prior to and/or during the time the premises are undergoing repairs the use thereof by with interest at six per cent. If prior to and/or during the time the premises are undergoing repairs the use thereof by lessee is materially interfered with, the rent accruing during such period or periods shall abate.
- (5)—Removal of Property. Lessee shall have the right at any time during the continuance of this lease or within thirty (30) days after its termination to sever and remove all buildings and improvements, fixtures, equipment and other property owned by lessee or placed on said premises by lessee during the term of this or any previous lease or any extension
- (6)—Lessee's Right of Termination. Should lessee be prevented from establishing or continuing the business of distributing petroleum products on the whole or any part of said premises, due to any law, ordinance or regulation by any within ninety (90) days then the lessee may terminate this lease upon giving thirty (30) days' written notice, in which event the rental obligation shall be pro-rated from the date that the lessee is prevented in any manner from doing business on said premises.
