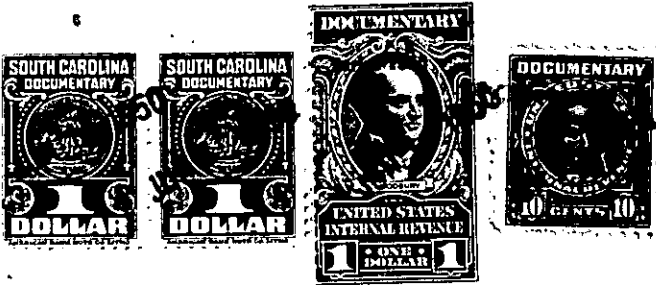

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. Warren White

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Fifty & No/100
(\$550.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Jack D. Parker, H. M. Allison and Hugh Smith,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jack D. Parker, H. M. Allison
and Hugh Smith, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All of my right, title and interest, the same being an undivided
one-fifth interest, in and to

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in City of Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, located at the Southwestern intersection of
Arlington Avenue and Calhoun Street and designated as a portion of
Lot No. 1 according to a plat which was recorded in Plat Book A at
page 229 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southwestern intersection of
Arlington Avenue and Calhoun Street and running thence along the
Southern side of Arlington Avenue, N. 70-53 W. 50 feet to a stake at
the corner of lot now or formerly owned by C. H. Wyatt and Edwina
Wyatt; thence with the Wyatt line, S. 18-48 W. 148 feet to a stake
in the line of the property now or formerly owned by Elizabeth White
Bailey; thence along the Bailey line, S. 70-53 E. 49.5 feet to a stake
in the line of Calhoun Street; thence along the Westerly side of
Calhoun Street, N. 19-0 E. 148 feet to the point of beginning.
