The following Restrictive and Protective Covenant is hereby imposed on Sherwood Forest, a subdivision, as shown on a Plat Recorded in Plat Book Y, Page 23, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. This covenant and restriction is imposed not only for the benefit of the grantor but also for the benefit of each and every purchaser of any of the said property, their heirs and assigns, shall violate this covenant it shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning any of the said property to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity against the person or persons violating said covenant and either prevent such violation or recover damage or other dues for such violation: to-wit:

The premises shall not be owned or occupied by negroes or persons of negro blood.
