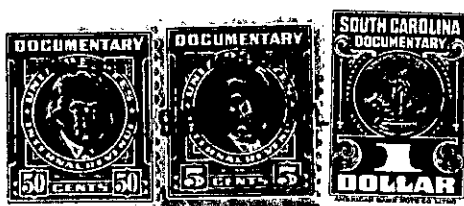

Dual Lane Highway No, 29, and also lying on the west side of Ashmore Street and the South side of Highland Drive, being all of lot no.22 on a plat of property made for Mrs. Geanie L. Caldwell by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated October 24-25, 1949, recorded in the R/ . M. C. office for Greenville County in plat Book X, at page I, having the following courses and distances:

Beginning on a stake at intersection of Ashmore Street and Highland Drive, and runs thence with south side of Highland Drive, N.62- 30 W. 85 feet to a stake, thence S. 36-45 W. 170 feet to a stake, corner with lot No. 21, thence with line of lot of lot No.21 N.78.00 E. 194 feet to a stake on west edge of Ashmore Street; thence therewith N. 10.00 W. 67 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to me by Mrs. Geanie L.
