KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Ben. F. Perry, of the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00.), and the benefits to be derived from the maintenance of said streets, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the Supervisor of Greenville County, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Supervisor of Greenville County,

the following streets in ~~all that piece or parcel of land in~~ Paris Mountain Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, in the Sans Pouce Heights Sub-Division on the New Buncombe Road about five miles north of the City of Greenville opposite the Skyland Theater, the said streets being thirty-four (34) feet wide and being known and designated as follows:-

- Woodlawn Drive running from the New Buncombe Road to the Tindal Road.
- St. Pleasant Avenue running from the New Buncombe Road to the Tindal Road.
- Skyland Avenue running from the New Buncombe Road to the Tindal Road.
- Herrilat Avenue running from the New Buncombe Road to the Tindal Road.
- Corine Avenue running from the New Buncombe Road to the Tindal Road.
- Langston Drive running from the New Buncombe Road to the Tindal Road.
- Farnshaw Avenue running from Skyland Avenue to Herrilat Avenue.
- Callahan Avenue running from Skyland Avenue to Herrilat Avenue.

said roads being more fully shown on Plat of said property recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book "1" at page 25, which Plat is hereby referred to and made a part hereof.

The above described land is a part of the same conveyed to me by Frances T. Tindal, et al., and E. Inman, Master, on the third day of January, 1950, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 399 Page s 236 and 215.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Supervisor of Greenville County, his successors, Heirs and Assigns forever.
