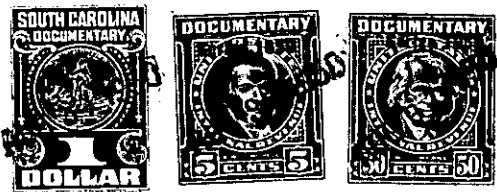

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Annie Belle H. Carey, her Heirs and Assigns
forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 48 on a Map of
Lincoln Town, Paris, South Carolina, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Green-
ville County, in Plat Book "S" at page 39 and having, according to said Map,
the following metes and bounds, to-wit: -

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Wynette Avenue, joint
corner of Lots Nos. 47 and 48, and running thence with line of Lot No. 47 S.
86-0 E., 150 feet to an iron pin in line of lot No. 43; thence with line of
lot No. 43, N. 4-00 E., 40 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 48
and 49; thence with line of lot No. 49, N. 86 - 0 W., 150 feet to an iron pin
