WHEREAS, Stanley I. Coleman is the owner of a two inch water line which crosses his tract of land on Geer Highway, in Bates Township, for a distance of approximately fifteen hundred feet, beginning at the thirty-six inch water main leading to the City of Greenville and running in a Northerly direction to a point near the rear of the residence of the said Stanley I. Coleman; and

WHEREAS, Stanley I. Coleman is also the owner of two other water lines (one being a 1/2" line and the other being a 1" line), both of which begin at the terminus of said two inch water line and one of which now serves the residence of E. R. Jones on the West side of Geer Highway and the other of which serves property of Allen League, E. R. Jones, A. B. Crain, James A. Rackley, the Pridmore Estate, Carrie J. Wellis and T. H. Maddox, all of which property is located on the Northeast side of Geer Highway; and

WHEREAS, E. R. Jones, Allen League, and perhaps A. B. Crain, James A. Rackley, the Pridmore Estate, Carrie J. Wellis, and T. H. Maddox, or their predecessors in title, entered into agreements with the predecessor in title of Stanley I. Coleman under which agreements they are now obtaining water from the two water lines referred to in the foregoing paragraph for a monthly charge; and

WHEREAS, the Parties of the Second Part are interested in extending said two inch water line so as to run it along the
