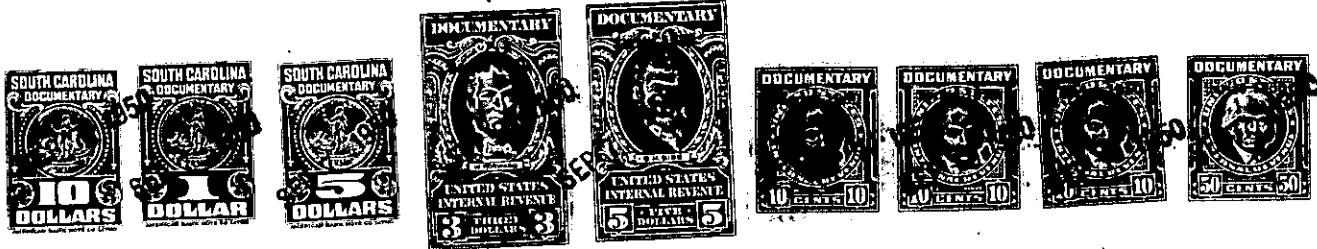

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the East side of West Decatur Street, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot 107, on plat of property of J. P. Rosamond, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1931, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "H", at page 185, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
