SALE OF TIMBER

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, Boyd E. Mills, Trustee under the terms of the Will of J.H. Mills, deceased, and by authority given in the same, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty-one Hundred (\$8100.00) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto J.C. Walker and E. Barton and their heirs and assigns:

All the marketable saw timber now standing on the tract of land belonging to the Estate of J.H. Mills, containing 382 Acres, more or less, known as the Cannon place, situated near Camp Creek Baptist Church, about 10 miles Northwest of Greer and three miles East of Tigerville, in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. This sale includes all trees large enough to saw into lumber.

The said J.C. Walker and T.E. Barton, their employees, heirs or assigns, shall have the right and privilege of entering upon said tract of land at convenient places for the purpose of cutting, sawing and removing said timber or lumber according to custom, at any time within two years from this date.

Unto the said J.C. Walker and T.E. Barton and their heirs and assigns, and I hereby bind myself as Trustee under the Will of J.H. Mills, deceased, and my successors to warrant and defend the aforesaid timber conveyance unto the said J.C. Walker and T.E. Barton and their heirs and assigns, according to the terms of this contract.
