"BE IT RESOLVED That the County Board of Education for Greenville County does hereby ratify, confirm and approve the sale of that property shown as Lots 2, 40, 41, 42 and 43 on plat of property of Ellison G. Glenn, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "F", at page 148, by the Trustees of the School District of the City of Greenville, to the said Ellison G. Glenn, all of which is shown by deed of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 265, at page 317, which deed bears date of July 11, 1944."

The above resolution is offered in confirmation of the action of the Greenville County Board of Education in special session on October 7, 1950, when, upon motion of Mr. M. G.
