Know all Men by these presents, That

I, Margaret Ella Pulliam, of Greenville County,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

to me paid by R. D. Bishop and Juanita M. Bishop

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. D. Bishop and Juanita M. Bishop, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, about two miles West of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as the greater portion of Lot No. 6 of a subdivision of the property of T. T. Norris, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book I, at page 148, and having, according to a recent survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service for Margaret Pullian on August 10, 1950, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Bradley Street at a point approximately 290 feet North of the intersection of White Circle Road, which point is 5 feet North of the corner of Lot No. 7, and running thence N. 64-46 E. 160 feet to an iron pin at a point 5 feet North of the rear corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 4; thence S. 25-30 E. 5 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 4; thence along the line of Lot No. 4, N. 64-46 E. 25 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 5; thence along the line of Lot No. 5, N. 25-30 W. 64.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64-51 W. 185 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Bradley Street; thence along the East side of Bradley Street, S. 25-30 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is a portion of the property conveyed to me by Vivia M. Morris by deed dated March 27, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 293, at page 289.

The grantees are to pay taxes for 1950.
