KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Vantross Franklin, Elizabeth Calhoun, J. C. Franklin, Geo. C. Franklin, Benj. S. Franklin, Robert Franklin, Nannie F. Miller, Alice F. Land and Lula F. Pope
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00)
Dollars
to in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by O. C. Ferguson and Victoria Ferguson
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said O. C. Ferguson and Victoria Ferguson
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township,
County. State of South Carolina in the Laurel Creek section, containing 4 acres, more or less, according to plat made by J. Mac Richardson, dated
October, 1949 and it is shown on the Richardson plat as lot number
34 and has the following courses and distances and metes and bounds:
Beginning at a corner of lands of Charles Abercrombie as shown on
the plat as lot number 32 at Bannon's land and runs thence along
Bannon's line N. 38 E. 752.4 feet to corner on lot number 35 which
was the lot conveyed to O. C. Ferguson; thence along line of the
lands of O. C. Ferguson and Newton Bell S. 2-15 E. 756.2 feet to
corner on Charles Abercrombie; thence along Abercrombie line N
72-W. 518.8 feet to the beginning corner.

The described lot of land was a portion of the real estate owned by G. C. Franklin at the time of his death. Said G. C. Franklin died intestate a number of years ago leaving the grantors hereof as his sole heirs at law, they being his widow and children.
