KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Martha Chandler, of Route 3  
 Belton, Greenville County

in the state aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five (5.00) Dollars and  
 Love and Affection  
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these

presents by Robert D. Chandler of Greenville County, State of South Carolina

( the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and re-  
 leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
 Robert D. Chandler All that certain lot of land containing one (1) acre  
 more or less lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County  
 of Greenville, in Dunklin Township, West of the Holliday Bridge Road  
 about one and a half miles south of West Dunklin School, having the  
 following metes and bounds, to wit:- Beginning at an iron pin near the  
 center of the Holliday Bridge Road running along a line of a track of  
 land belonging to Sallie May G. Reeves S 87-45 W 295.5 feet to an iron  
 pin; thence N 13 W 150 feet along a line of a track of land belonging to  
 Martha Chandler to an iron pin; thence N 87-45 E 295.5 feet along a line  
 of a track of land owned by Martha Chandler to an iron pin in the Holliday  
 Bridge Road; thence S 13 E 150 feet down the Holliday Bridge Road along a  
 line of a track of land owned by Syble Gosset Vaughn.

This lot is a portion of a six acre track of land conveyed on the 30th
