All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate on the west side of Rowley Street, in Ward 2, City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being the northern half of lot No. 36 as shown on plat made by J. E. Serrine on October 6, 1904 for Stone Land Company and revised by the said J. E. Serrine May 27, 1909, more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of lot No. 34 and running thence along Rowley Street S. 20-19 W. 51.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 69-29 W. 210 feet to an iron pin on a twelve foot alley; thence with said alley N. 20-19 E. 51.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 69-29 E. 210 feet to the beginning corner.
