my true and lawful attorney in fact, for me and in my name, place and stead, to act in, manage, and conduct all my estate and all my affairs, particularly with relation to all my property; including real, personal and mixed property of every nature, kind and description, and wheresoever situated, and including all other matters whatsoever, whether or not of like character with those above mentioned, in which I may be in any manner interested or concerned. For that purpose, for me and in my name, place and stead, and as my act and deed, I particularly, but in no way limiting the generality of the foregoing, except as provided in paragraph numbered 11 hereof, authorize and empower my said attorney, at any and all places, to do and execute, or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself therein in the doing or executing of, all or any of the following acts, deeds, and things, that is to say:

1. REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY. To buy, receive, lease, rent, accept or otherwise acquire real or personal property in my name or on my behalf; to sell, convey, quitclaim, mortgage, hypothecate, pledge, execute Deeds of Trust covering or otherwise encumber or dispose of, or to contract or agree for the disposal or encumbrance of; upon such terms as my said attorney shall deem proper, all my right, title and interest, community, homestead, or otherwise, in and to any and all real or personal property in which I now have or may hereafter acquire an interest; and as my act and deed, and on my behalf, to sign, execute, acknowledge, and deliver any and all instruments in writing of whatsoever kind and nature, as may be necessary or convenient in the premises, including waiver of homestead, curtesy or dower.

To take, hold, possess, lease, or let, or otherwise manage and control, any or all of my said real or personal property, or any interest therein, to eject, remove, or relieve tenants, or other persons from, and recover possession of such real or personal property, by all lawful means; to maintain; protect; preserve, insure, remove, store, transport, repair, build on, raze; rebuild, alter, modify or improve the said real or personal property, or any part thereof.

The provisions of this paragraph shall and do specifically authorize and empower my attorney to sell, transfer, mortgage or otherwise encumber or dispose of any right, title, or interest which I now have, or hereafter may acquire, in and to any motor vehicle; and, as my act and deed, and on my behalf, to sign, endorse, execute, acknowledge, and deliver any Certificate of Title to said vehicle, or other instrument in writing of whatsoever kind or nature, as may be necessary convenient, or proper in the premises.

2: GENERAL POWERS REGARDING INSTRUMENTS IN WRITING. To make, indorse, accept, receive, sign, seal, execute, acknowledge, and deliver deeds, assignments, agreements, certificates, hypothecations, checks, notes, bonds, vouchers, receipts, releases, and such other instruments in writing of whatever kind and nature as may be necessary, convenient, or proper in carrying out any of the provisions hereof.
