of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Furman C. Smith and J. McD Bruce, all the right, title and interest of the Plaintiff and Defendants, In and to the following described real estate:

"All that lot of land on the Northeast side of East Pinehurst Drive, in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown as Lot 29, on plat of property of Helen M. Powe, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, June, 1944, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Grenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "P", at Page 65, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of East Pinehurst Driv at joint front corner of Lots 28 and 29, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 28, N. 1-15 E. 235.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 87-32 E. 161.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 14-05 W. 255.2 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot 18; thence with the line of Lot 18, N. 89-52 W. 95 feet to an iron pin on the East side of East Pinehurst Drive; thence with the curve of East Pinehurst Drive, in a northwesterly direction, 21 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner."
