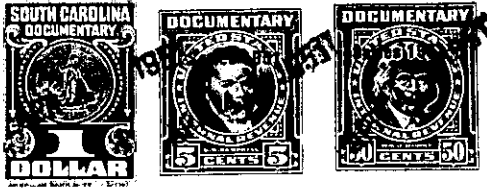

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That we, William Maxwell and  
Buster Lewis, of the County of Greenville  
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars  
to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by Genever Adams  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Genever Adams, Heirs and assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the north side  
of a country road leading to Lakeside from Greenville; and being  
more fully described by a plat made by W.J. Middle, Surveyor,  
February, 1951, recorded in the R.E.C. Office for Greenville County  
in Plat Book Z, at page 167, and having according to said Plat  
the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEING at an iron pin at the front joint corner of this  
tract of land and another containing .89 of an acre, and  
running thence N. 3-34 E. 309 feet to an iron pin on a branch  
in the line of Jeff Ware's property and Erby Goldsmith's  
property; thence N. 34-00 W. with the Jeff Ware line 337.6  
feet to an iron pin; thence S. 2-51 E. 700 feet to an iron  
pin on said country road; thence N. 11-00 E. 130 feet, with  
said country road to an iron pin; thence N. 74-30 E. 100  
feet with said country road to the point of beginning, and  
containing 1.80 of an acre, more or less.
