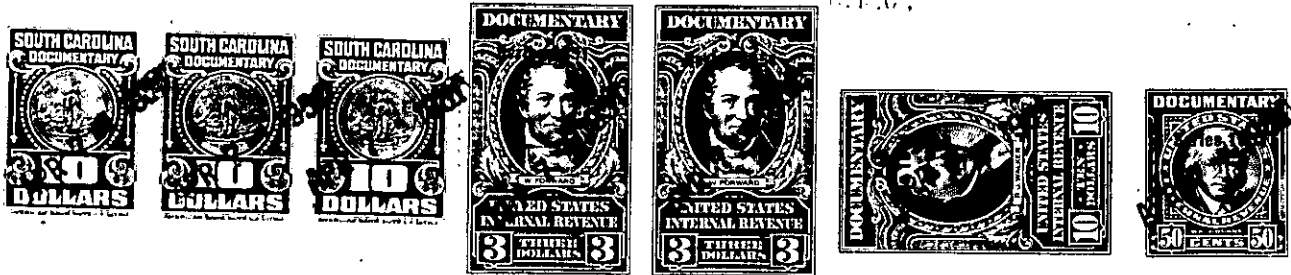

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, formerly in the town of West Greenville but  
now in the city of Greenville, known and designated as lot No. 43  
of the J. E. Speegle land, fronting 50 feet on the south side of  
Perry Avenue, and extending back a depth of 190 feet, this being  
the same property conveyed to me by E. M. Galphin by deed dated  
October 4, 1945 recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in Deed Book 281, page 166, reference being craved to said  
deed for a more complete description.

ALSO all that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Greenville town-  
ship, Greenville County, state of South Carolina on the south side  
of Gandy Street, and being known and designated as lot No. 113 of  
Nicholtown as per revised plat of W. J. Riddle, recorded in the  
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, page 4. This  
being the same property conveyed to me by C. B. Martin by deed dated  
December 5, 1941 recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in Deed Book 240, page 100, reference being craved to said  
deed for a more complete description.

ALSO all that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Greenville town-  
ship, Greenville County, state of South Carolina on the southeast  
side of what is known as the National Highway, formerly known as  
Melrose Avenue but now known as Green Avenue. This being the same  
property conveyed to me by Mary Ann Phillips by deed dated April  
1, 1946 recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in  
Deed Book 290, page 105, reference being craved to said deed for  
a more complete description.

ALSO all those two pieces, parcels, or lots of land in Gantt  
township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, located about  
four miles from Greenville, just off Old Anderson Road (state High-  
way No. 81) being known and designated as tracts numbers 24 and 26  
as shown on plat of a portion of Dixie Farms recorded in the R. M. C.  
Office for Greenville County in Plat Book L, page 5. This being  
the same property conveyed to me by Walter W. Goldsmith and E. R.  
Parker by deed dated December 20, 1940 recorded in the R. M. C.
