Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Ethel S. Jones OLLIE FARNSWORTH in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Thousand and no/100 (\$18,000.00) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Margaret F. DuPree, her heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, on the south side of Cleveland Street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 9 of the property of Parris, Gower and Martin as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book G, at page 197, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Cleveland Street at the corner of Lot No. 8, which point is 373 feet west of the southwest corner of the intersection of Cleveland Street and McDaniel Avenue, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 8, S. 20-34 W. 180 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot; thence N. 69-26 W. 66 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 10; thence along the line of that lot, N. 20-34 E. 180 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the south side of Cleveland Street; thence along the line of said Cleveland Street, S. 69-26 E. 66 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is the same as conveyed to Ethel S. Jones by A. E. Jones by deed dated February, 1936 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 394, at page 295 on October 25, 1949 at 5:15 P.M.

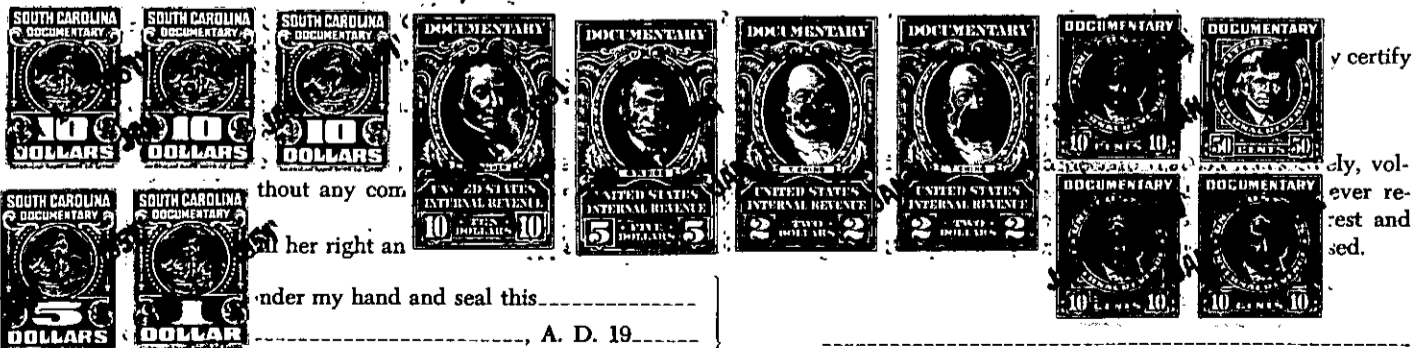
