That I, Ann Carver Williams in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ONE & NO/100 DOLLARS, Love and affection to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Florence Reid, her heirs and assigns

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Buncombe Road, containing five and sixty-one-hundredths (5.60) acres, more or less, about eighteen miles north of Greenville Court House, being part of the lands of John Henry Trammell, known and designated as tract No. 1 of said lands, according to a map made by W. J. Riddle, August 22, 1941, described as follows:

BEGINNING at McDaniel corner on said Buncombe Road and running thence with McDaniel line, S. 74-30 W. 1415 feet to a pin on line of Lot No. 2; thence with the line of Lot No. 2, S. 60 W. 1331 feet to Buncombe Road; thence with Buncombe Road, N. 36-30 W. 350 feet to the beginning corner.
