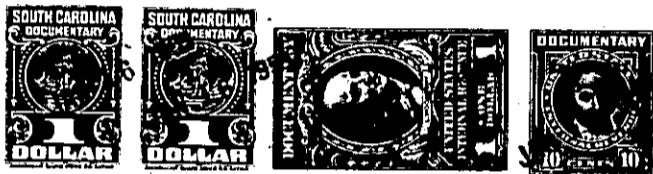

All that piece, parcel, or lot of la.d, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying, and being near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot 159, Section 1, as shown on a plat entitled "Subdivision of Village Houses, F. W. Poe Mfg. Co., Greenville, S. C. ", made by Dalton & Reeves, July 1950, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book V, at pages 26-31, inclusive. According to said plat, the within described lot is also known as No. 24 Fifth Street (Avenue) and fronts thereon 65 feet.
