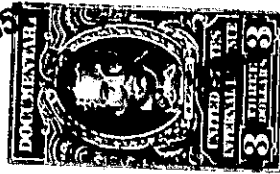

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Local Home Builders, Inc.

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina

and having its principal place of business at

Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration

of the sum of Twenty-six Hundred Twenty-five and no/100 Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee

hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and

released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto James Robert McAlister,

his Heirs and Assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the Westerly side of Welcome Street, near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 16 on the plat of Talmer Cordell Subdivision as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, Plat Book "X", page 179, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Westerly side of Welcome Street at a point 430 feet South of the Southwest corner of the intersection of Welcome Street and Welcome Road, joint front corner of lots 15 and 16 and running thence along the joint line of said lots S 76-0 W 160 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot No. 3; thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 3 and 2 S 14-0 E 60 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 16 and 17; thence along the joint line of Lots 16 and 17 N 76-0 E 160 feet to an iron pin on the Westerly side of Welcome Street; thence along the Westerly side of Welcome Street N 14-0 W 60 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is conveyed subject to a mortgage given by the grantor herein to More, Inc. on Nov. 13, 1950, in the amount of \$5,000.00 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Vol. 483, page 36.
