in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Thousand Five Hundred & no/100 - (\$15,500.00)-DOLLARS,

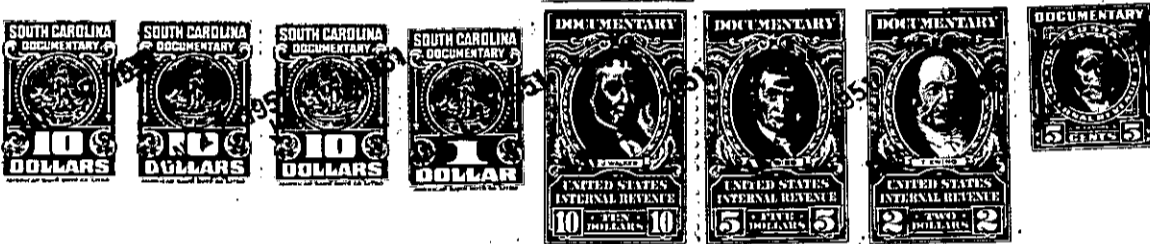

J. Neal and Eva L. Neal, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the North side of Crescent Avenue (formerly known as Mills Avenue), in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, shown as Lot 6 of Block B, on plat of Cagle Park, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, June 1915, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "C", at pages 237 and 238, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Crescent Avenue, at joint corner of Lots 5 and 6, of Block B, and running thence along the rear line of Lots 4 and 5, N 28-42 W 178.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N 73-01 E 88 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 7, S 21-44 E 180.1 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Crescent Avenue; thence along Crescent Avenue, S 79-12 W 14.2 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Crescent Avenue, S 76-44 W 52.8 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the Grantor by deed of Relief and Annuity Board of the Southern Baptist Convention, dated July 10, 1947, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 315, at page 171.
