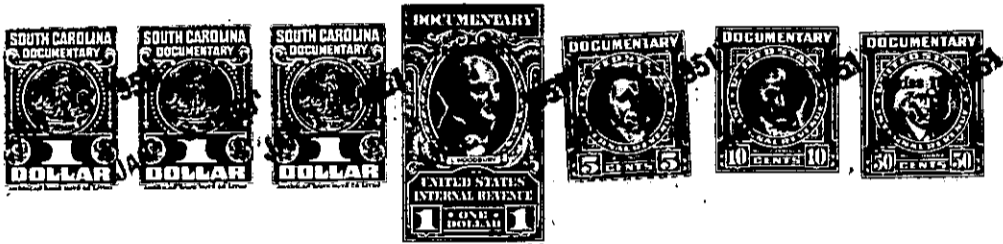

ARMSTRONG, his heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Southwest side of Claremore Avenue, being known as Lot No. 2 of Block L, Section 5, on a plat of East Highland Estates recorded in Plat Book "K" at Pages 78, 79 and 80.
