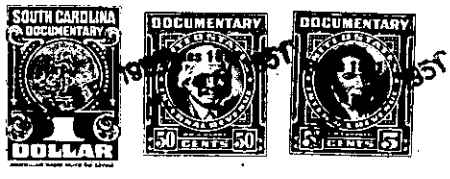

Traxler, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Southern side of Pacific Avenue within the limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot #360 according to plat of Pleasant Valley, prepared by Dalton & Neves in April 1946, as revised through September 1950, as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book P, page 114, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Pacific Avenue in the Southeast corner of the intersection of Pacific Avenue with Pasadena Avenue; thence around the Southeast corner of said intersection on an angle, the chord of which is S. 29-32 W. 105.7 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Pasadena Avenue; thence along said Avenue S. 29-47 E. 165 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots 395 and 360; thence N. 89-52 E. 74.3 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots 360 and 361; thence N. 0-08 W. 160 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Pacific Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 360 and 361; thence along said Pacific Avenue S. 89-52 W. 60 feet to an iron pin in the Southeast corner of the intersection of Pacific Avenue with Pasadena Avenue, the point of beginning.
